We greatly appreciate your support with this, as it reduces any embarrassment for your children when they are asked to remove items which are not in line with the school policy.

We would also great appreciate your help with your child's homework. We have greatly reduced the amount of homework expected over the last couple of years, to focus mainly on reading and maths. The remaining homework is key, and we really appreciate those families who complete it regularly. Where it is not completed, we can see an impact on pupils' attainment and confidence in class. Please help us support your children by helping them to complete this homework as frequently as possible.
