A word from Mr Lloyd

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope everyone is refreshed after the half term and ready for Autumn 2, which is one of the busiest but most fun terms of the year. We've had a busy week, with school trips and a day working with our Trust on assessment.

Woodside is part of the ODBST (Oxford Diocese Bucks Schools Trust) and, as a result of this, we are assigned a School Effectiveness Partner who works with us over the course of the year. We receive at least 6 visits every year, looking at different aspects of the school from behaviour to pupil results. This week, our partner visited us to look at assessment. This involved looking at pupil's books, how we mark, how we assess children and what we use this information for. She was very pleased with the work at Woodside, commenting that we have a "highly skilled and effective staff" and that we always aim to put the needs of the children first. Thanks to all the teachers who helped us with this visit; we have a great team here at Woodside and it's lovely to see it recognised by others from outside of the school.

Within the Trust, there are 13 different primary schools from across Buckinghamshire. We work together on projects such as developing writing, safeguarding and behaviour management. Woodside gains a lot of benefits from being part of the Trust and we are seeking to further develop our links with local schools in the coming years.

I would like to remind families of a couple of items. Firstly, please do not park on the single yellow lines, double yellow lines or zig-zag markings outside of the school. Parking is not permitted on any of these during school hours. On Tuesday, our coach was returning with the Y5 children from a school trip and was held up in standstill traffic due to people being parked incorrectly. It endangers our children and members of the community, please respect the road markings.

Secondly, a lot of children have started to wear necklaces, bracelets and earrings to school. These are not permitted under our uniform policy. Many have said that they have had their ears pierced over the summer, so by this point in the year they should be able to remove earrings during the day as the piercing will have healed. Please support us with this aspect of the uniform policy.
