## English

Our topic for this half term is 'Ancient Greece'.

Our book focus for this half term will be 'Pandora's Box'.

Writing lessons will focus on varying sentence structures, clauses and imagery.

We will be writing a monologue, information leaflets, explanation texts and some free verse poetry.

## Maths

This half term we will focus on understanding and calculating area and multiplication and division.



## Science

Our Science unit continues to be States of Matter. We will be learning about the water cycle and how water evaporates.

## History

We will be studying Ancient Greece and its impact on later civilizations.
